

How do I get New York Times access?

All Students, Faculty, and Staff have free access to *The New York Times*. However, setup must be done on campus initially. Thereafter, you will be able to access *The New York Times* online from anywhere! Here are the steps:

Step 1. To set up access, visit: <https://myaccount.nytimes.com/grouppass/access> or scan the QR code:




