

Each topic has a variety of resources available such as academic journals, videos, infographics, news articles, and statistics. Articles can be read aloud, translated, and made legible.

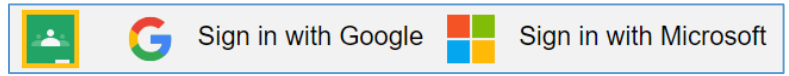
 **Speaker Icon:** The article can be read aloud by the computer for easy note taking.

## Creating Your Account

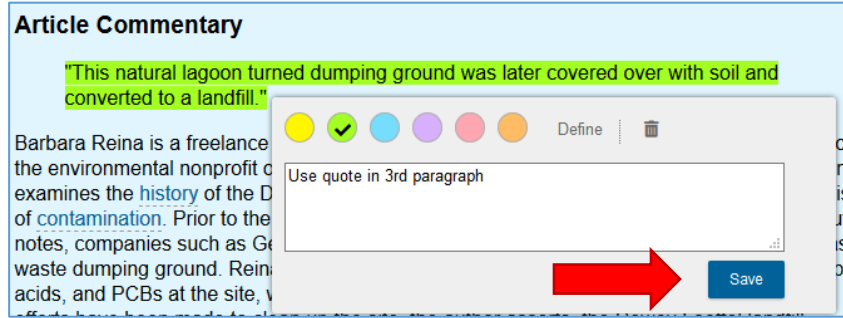
Save, highlight, and take notes when you create an account.



- Simply **Sign in** with your Google or Microsoft account.

- Next, save highlights and notes to either your Google or Microsoft accounts as well.

1. First, highlight the passage with the mouse.
2. A menu pop-up will allow you to choose a highlight color and make notes.



3. Once the passage is highlighted, click the **Save** button at the bottom of the pop-up menu.
4. Click on either the OneDrive or Google drive icon at the top of the article (pictured below) to complete the save process.

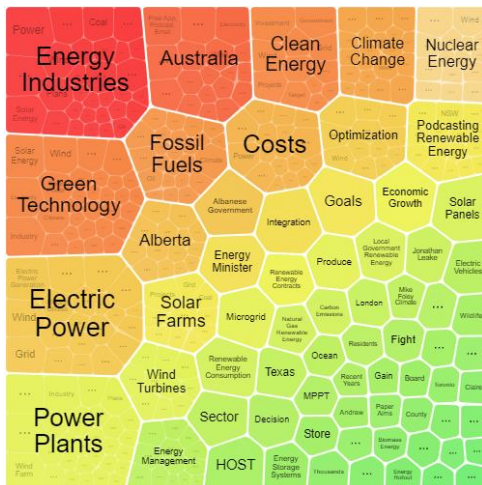


- The saved article will have your highlights. At the bottom of the document it will have a section of all highlighted items.
